

DIY Flip Book

ACTIVITY CAMPS

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- Key Rings (if not you can use string)
- Plain Paper
- Scissors
- Hole Punch
- Card



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start by cutting a plain piece of paper until 6 pieces—once length ways down the middle, then cut each half into 3 equal pieces
- 2. Split the paper cut outs into 3 piles—one will be the top of the face (hair and eyes), one will be the middle section of the face (ears and nose), then the final section can be the bottom of the face (mouth and chin).
- 3. Draw lots of different funny facial features using different styles of drawing and different colours. You might want to include, beards, moustaches, bushy eyebrows, long eyelashes, glasses, freckles, different eye colours and shapes and you can include animal features in this too!
- 4. Carefully hole punch each piece of paper in the middle of the left hand side.
- 5. Use a piece of card for the back of the book, hole punch this three times down the left hand side.
- 6. The card should be the width of the paper cut outs, and long enough to fit all 3 sections on (three times the height of one section)
- 7. Using either the key rings or the string, thread through the hole you have made for each section (paper and the card backing), Repeat this for each section of the face.
- 8. This will create your own flip book, turn over each piece of paper and different times to reveal your funny faces!
