

- Title:** Specialist Instructor (Trampoline Coach)
- Reporting to:** Camp Manager
- Contract:** Seasonal work available in school holidays (Easter, Summer and half terms).
- Hours:** Usually 8.30am – 5.30pm weekdays, but shorter hours can be considered. Full season or part season roles available.
- Pay:** £64.44 – £105.19 per day (plus 12.07% holiday pay) based on experience, qualifications & shift length.

Summary of Position:

Our Specialist Instructor (Trampoline Coach) role is focused on delivering fun, structured trampolining sessions for groups of children aged between 4 and 14 years old. Between trampolining duties, you will have the opportunity to be part of our Instructor team and deliver sports sessions, arts crafts activities and games to the children, with an emphasis being on participation, care and skill development.

As well as leading sessions, staff contribute to the high standard of physical, emotional and social care offered by Ultimate Activity Camps. Our Instructors have a pastoral role as the leader of a group of children on camp, with the focus being on maintaining welfare and providing high quality care.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Deliver enjoyable, structured trampolining sessions to groups of children, working both alone and alongside other staff.
- Lead the safe set up and pack down of the trampolines and any accompanying equipment.
- Take a pastoral role as a group leader, welcoming new children into your group and liaising with the Camp Manager and/or parents as necessary.
- Supervise and engage with the children outside of activity times.
- Continuously promote the welfare of the children in your care.
- Show high levels of energy, enthusiasm and professionalism, acting as a suitable role model for the children.
- Ensure all policies and procedures on camp are adhered to by yourself and the children in your care, including all health and safety, and safeguarding procedures.
- Live up to the Ultimate Activity Camp promise of 'Inspiring Children Every Day' and behave in a manner that reflects the expectations of the company throughout your employment.
- Other ad-hoc duties (e.g., cleaning, equipment maintenance etc).

Essential Requirements:

- Qualified trampoline coach holding a minimum British Gymnastics Level 2, with experience working with children of all ages. Other coaching or teaching experience desirable.
- Able to tailor delivery and structure according to age and ability.
- Be enthusiastic, energetic and passionate about working developing children through play and activity.
- Good organisation and communication skills. Candidates must be confident in their ability to lead a group of children and not shy away from responsibility.
- A flexible, team player, able to adapt to dynamic situations and challenges on camp.
- Someone looking for a challenging but hugely rewarding and fun job in the holidays, looking to further their career in the childcare and coaching industry.

Desirable Requirements:

- Experience taking sole charge of a group of children.
- Hold a Paediatric First Aid (12 hour or 6 hour) or First Aid at Work qualification.
