Summary of Position:

The role of the Activity & Equipment Coordinator is to assist with the safe delivery of camp under the COVID-19 guidance set out by the government.

You will be expected to assist the camp staff with the set-up, cleaning and preparation of classroom areas and equipment, so they can be used safely during the next timetabled session. You will act as a floating staff member to assist with the movement of children around the camp setting when other staff members are unable to leave their bubble.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with setting up equipment ready for the safe delivery of camp activities.
- Assist with sign-in procedures, acting as a runner and welcoming children on to camp.
- Assist with the implementation of procedures relating to infection prevention through cleaning and disinfecting surfaces, classroom areas and equipment.
- To ensure we maintain staff:child ratios, you must be prepared to cover staff absence by delivering a range of engaging activities to children aged 4-14.
- Ensure all policies and procedures on camp are adhered to by yourself and the children on camp, including all health and safety, and safeguarding procedures.
- Continuously promote the welfare of the children and contribute to the high standard of physical, emotional and social care offered by Ultimate Activity Camps.
- Help to set up the Ultimate Activity Camp by attending a Camp Induction Day.
- At all times behave in a manner that reflects the expectations of Ultimate Activity Camps.
