

TEFL TEACHER



Ultimate Activity Camps offer English lessons on camp to international children. With programmes designed and operated by partner company, Varsity International Summer Schools, the role of TEFL teacher is to deliver English lessons to children in ability classes of up to 12 students on camp. With accompanying resources and session plans, you will be required to plan and deliver English lessons to international children, and take a lead role in supporting full integration between International and British children on camp.

In between lessons you will be part of the great Ultimate Activity Camps instructor team, helping to deliver activities and supporting international children within their groups. Experience with young learners (4 – 14 years) is preferable for this role.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Deliver engaging English lessons for classes of up to 12 children in ability level groups from beginner to advanced.
2. Support other staff on camp to integrate children into the activity programme.
3. Ensure all policies and procedures on camp are adhered to by yourself and the children in your care, including health and safety, and safeguarding procedures.
4. Take a pastoral role welcoming new children into your group and liaising with the Camp Manager, Academic Manager and/or parents as necessary.
5. Monitor student progress and provide written feedback to parents in report form at the end of each **student's** time on camp.
6. At all times behave in a manner that reflects the expectations of Ultimate Activity Camps.
7. Live up to the Ultimate Activity Camp promise of 'Inspiring Children Every Day' throughout your employment
8. Show the required energy, enthusiasm and professionalism for the duration of the season, acting as an ambassador for Ultimate Activity Camps and behaving as a suitable role model for children.
9. Other ad-hoc duties (cleaning, equipment maintenance/ordering etc.)

Requirements:

- CELTA/TESOL qualified or PGCE (Primary, English or MFL) or equivalent.
- Experience in teaching English to foreign students, preferably of primary school age (4-11).
- Experience of teaching English as a foreign language to children of different nationalities, ability and age.
- Experience of holiday summer schools or activity camps is desirable
- Enthusiastic, energetic individual, passionate about working with, and developing children through play, learning and activity
- Good organisation and communication skills.
- Flexible, team player, able to adapt to dynamic situations and challenges on camp.
- Someone looking for a challenging, different but hugely rewarding and fun job in the holidays, and looking to further their career in the childcare and coaching industry
